Letter of Intent to Homeschool

General Form Information

When and where do I need to submit this form?

The state of Minnesota requires homeschoolers to notify the superintendent of their local school district when they:

- Initially withdraw from public school (within 15 days of withdrawal)
- Continue homeschooling for another school year (by October 1 of the school year)
- Move out of the school district (within 15 days of changing residence)

At what age does my child need this form submitted?

This form is required for children aged 7 to 17. If your child is 6 or younger when you would otherwise need to submit this form, you <u>do not</u> need to submit it. A child who has already met the requirements for high school graduation, or who withdraws from school for the first time at the age of 17, does not need to submit this form.

Do I need to submit an immunization statement?

If this is your first time submitting this form for a child, you need to submit either an immunization record or a notarized statement of conscientious exemption to immunizations. If you have not submitted a conscientious exemption statement, then you will also need to submit an immunization record when your child enters 7th grade (age 12).

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This document meets all parent/guardian reporting requirements of Minn. Stat. §§ 120A.22-120A.26 (2017).

(To Parent/Guardian: submit this form to your school district's superintendent within 15 days of (1) a child's initial withdrawal from public school or (2) moving out of the school district. Also submit it by October 1 of each school year for children aged 7 to 16 who continue to homeschool.)
